## Day 1 (5<sup>th</sup> Aug) – Arrive in Colombo and R&R.

Colombo is the executive and judicial capital and largest city of Sri Lanka by population. Colombo metropolitan area has a population of 5.6 million. It is the financial center of the island and a tourist destination.

Sri Lanka (formerly Ceylon) was ruled by the Dutch, the Portuguese, and the British for a long period of time, and the trails of which still reflect in Colombo's cultural heritage. From the art to architecture, historical monuments to traditional restaurants, temples to amusement parks, and from scenic nature to smiling people.

Staying at Taj Samudra Hotel

For people arriving in Sri Lanka on day flights – options to do some light shopping stroll down Galle Face Green and Colombo Port City watching the sunset.



## Day 2 (6<sup>th</sup> Aug) – Golf day/Colombo City Tour

6.30-8am – Buffet breakfast at the Hotel.

9am – 18-hole round at ROYAL COLOMBO GOLF CLUB

The Royal Colombo Golf Club (Est 1879), is one of the finest golf clubs in Sri Lanka. The club is located in the heart of the city, and being one of only two golf courses in the city provides members and guests a great relaxation from their busy work schedules. The RCGC as it is popularly known is playing a prominent role in the development of the game of golf in the country. Brilliantly landscaped, the 18-hole golf course is immaculately maintained.

PM – Colombo City tour and stroll the Galle Face Green.

**Galle Face Green** is a vibrant oceanfront promenade in Colombo, Sri Lanka, known for its stunning **sunsets**. This area offers a lively atmosphere with locals and tourists enjoying street food, kite flying and strolling along the coast.

7pm onwards - Buffet dinner at the Hotel.



## Day 3 (7<sup>th</sup> Aug) – Travel to Kandy

6.30-8am – Buffet breakfast at the Hotel.

8.30 am – Check-out and travel to Kandy (3.5 hrs drive).

The city is situated in the midst of hills in the Kandy plateau. Kandy is the administrative capital of the Central Province, and considered as the cultural capital of Sri Lanka, due to its architectural heritage. This ancient kingdom of Kandy is home to the Temple of the Tooth Relic of Lord Buddha as well as Edwardian buildings, and a king-made lake.

12.30 pm – Check-in to the Victoria Golf Course resort & Spa Sanctuary in the Greens Experience the healing touch of Bali amidst the rolling hills.

Afternoon options - lunch & Bar refreshments (user pays), Tennis, Hikes, visit a local Buddhist temple, a 9-hole round of Golf (user pays), Kayaking in the local river (user pays) or relax by the pool.

Spa options - Svastha Serene Spa by Madhava Balinese Spa, a wellness sanctuary at Victoria Golf Resort. Combining ancient Balinese healing traditions with the tranquility of our landscape, Svastha offers a restorative escape for body and mind. ## Day 4 (8<sup>th</sup> Aug) – Golf day/Victoria Golf Course

6.30-8am – Buffet breakfast at the Hotel.

8.30 am – 18-hole round at Victoria Golf Course.

Victoria Golf & Country Resort in Kandy offers an idyllic play space for avid golfers and amateurs alike. Ranking among the best golf courses in the world.

This Digana area golf club features a meticulously designed and well maintained 73 Par, 6933-yard championship, 18-hole course.

Afternoon options – R&R, lunch & Bar refreshments (user pays), Tennis, Hikes, visit a local Buddhist temple, a 9-hole round of Golf (user pays), Kayaking in the local river (user pays) or relax by the pool.

Excursion options in the afternoon – to visit the Kandy town.

7pm onwards - Buffett dinner at the Hotel.



## Day 5 (9<sup>th</sup> Aug) – Golf day/Travel to Nuwara Eliya

6.30-8am – Buffet breakfast at the Hotel.

8.30 am – Optional, 9-hole round at Victoria Golf Course (user pays).

After the round of Golf, pool recovery and R&R.

12 noon – Check-out and travel to Nuwara Eliya (3 hrs drive).

Enroute – visit a Tea Factory.

Nuwara Eliya - At an altitude of over 1,800m above sea level the picturesque landscape of Nuwara Eliya is known as “Little England” because of the resemblance of its homesteads to English bungalows, and it’s cool climate

5.30pm – Check in to a Hotel in Nuwara Eliya.

5.30-7pm – wander around the Nuwara Eliya town for some local bargain shopping on some branded clothing or relax at the bar.

7pm onwards – dinner.



## Day 6 (10<sup>th</sup> Aug) – Golf day/Travel to Ella.

6.30-8am – Buffet breakfast at the Hotel.

8.30 am – 18-hole round at Nuwara Eliya Golf Course.

Nuwara Eliya Golf course Spread over 90 acres, over a hundred years old (built in 1891), the 18 holes golf course is one of Nuwara Eliya's biggest attractions.

After the round of Golf, refreshments (user pays) at the Golf Course and check-out.

2.00 pm – Travel to Ella (2 hours drive). Laid-back Ella draws travelers to Sri Lanka's highlands with its mountain forests, tea plantations, and relatively cool climate. The wildlife-rich region is also home to caves, cascades, and secluded temples—plus the Ella Gap, which offers lofty views between a cleft in two hills.

4pm – Options to visit the world famous Nine Arch Bridge and wander around Ella town for some touristy Café culture or relax at the bar.

7pm onwards – dinner.



## Day 7 (11<sup>th</sup> Aug) – AM -Rest/Travel to Hambantota.

7.00-8.30am – Buffet breakfast at the Hotel.

8.30-10.30 am – R&R or options to hike the Little Adam's Peak.

Little Adam's Peak hike offers one of the easiest ways to soak up incredible panoramic views of Ella and the surrounding mountains. This short and sweet hike in Sri Lanka takes you up to the perfect viewpoint just outside of town, and is an ideal sunrise or excursion.

11 am – check-out and travel to Hambantota (2 hours drive).

Enroute – visit the Elephant Orphanage at Udawalawe.

The Udawalawe Elephant Transfer Home is a facility within Udawalawe National Park in Sri Lanka. The Elephant Transit was established in 1995 by the Sri Lanka Department of Wildlife Conservation. Its primary objective is to rehabilitate orphaned elephant calves for ultimate release back into the wild.

3.30 pm – Check-in to a Hotel in Hambantota area. Rest & Relax by the pool.

7pm onwards – dinner.



## Day 8 (12<sup>th</sup> Aug) – Golf day/Hambantota.

6.30-8am – Buffet breakfast at the Hotel.

8.30 am – 18-hole round at Shangri-La's Hambantota Golf Club spreads across a coconut palm plantation, which offers not only stunning views but also exclusive challenges for golfers. This par 70 6107-yard course has three distinct zones with different characteristics, the Coconut Plantation, the Dune Area, and the Sapphire Mine.

After the round of Golf, refreshments (user pays) and R&R.

Afternoon – Either R&R by the pool or options to do a Jeep Safari either at the Yala National park or Udawalawe National park.

7pm onwards – farewell drinks and dinner.



## Day 9 (13<sup>th</sup> Aug) – R&R/Dutch Fort/Shopping/ Farewell dinner/airport departure/Tour finale.

6.30-8 am – Buffet breakfast at the Hotel.

8.00 -10 am – R&R and options for a Spa treatment.

10.30 am – Check-out and travel to Galle (2hrs drive).

12.30-2.30pm – Visit the Dutch Fort at Galle - Embark on a walking tour of the historic Galle Fortress, a UNESCO World Heritage site that showcases Sri Lanka's rich history and cultural heritage.

Options to have refreshments at the Galle International stadium.

2.30 pm – depart to Colombo (2.5 hrs drive).

5-7pm – Options for either shopping or refreshments at Galle Face.

7pm onwards – farewell drinks and dinner.

8.30pm – Depart to airport. 9.30pm – Flight check-ins and Tour ends.



## Tour details and costings

Tour includes:

- Four rounds (18 holes) of Golf with an optional 9-hole round at Victoria Course (user pays), with your own Caddies at all Courses and a Cart (twin share)\*.
- Accommodation in 5-star and 4.5-star hotels.
- Half board meals – breakfast and dinner provided throughout the tour.
- Transport provided throughout the tour as per the itinerary.
